- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students receiving a B or A in English from 69% (Yr 2 2017) to 75%
- Increase the percentage of Year 4 students receiving a B or A in English from 71% (Yr 3 2017) to 75%
- Increase the percentage of Year 5 students receiving a B or A in English from 67% (Yr 4 2017) to 75%
- Increase the U2B performance in Year 3 Writing from 66% (2017) to 75% (2018)
- Increase the U2B performance in Year 5 Writing from 29% (2017) to 45% (2018)
