These programs provide an APPROXIMATE timeline for each carnival. Times are to be used as a GUIDE ONLY. Events will be run in the order and within the session shown in the program.

Times may vary slightly from those shown.

This booklet provides an overview of the carnivals, and outlines some of the key information for the day.

CARNIVAL INFORMATION

Running of the Day

Each carnival will be run within normal school hours, across the whole school day, with normal breaks for eating and play. Children must arrive at school on the day of their carnival as they would any school day - go to their classrooms to meet their teachers and mark the role.

What to Bring

Students must come to school wearing swimwear under clothing. Don't forget to wear House colours! School bags and lunch boxes will remain at the classrooms to be accessed during break times. Bring a swim bag to the pool with goggles, drink bottle, hat and towel.

Carnival Age Groups

Senior Carnival – Grade 5 and 6 students born in 2006, 2007, 2008

PLUS 2008 born 50m swimmers in Grade 4.

Middle Carnival – Grade 3 and 4 students born 2008, 2009, 2010.

Swimmers will race in their year of birth (e.g. 2008: 10 years).

2008 Born 50m Swimmers in Grade 4

Due to this age group being eligible for school representation at District Swimming, these students will join the Senior Carnival for the sessions in which their 50m events will run. They will ALSO take part in the middle carnival with their classmates, swimming ONLY in the 25m events.

Race Nomination Closure

Nominations have been processed and pre-entered into the carnival programs. Final nomination lists have been placed into every classroom to allow students to take note of which events they have entered. Swimmers must compete in their designated races during the carnival. No late entries will be accepted.



Race Participation

Please discuss with your child the events they will swim so they are prepared. On the day, students must carefully listen to teachers and House Captains for when their races are called.

Competitive Event Structure

50m events in all strokes will be swum as TIMED FINALS. Rankings based on times will be calculated after all heats in that stroke have been completed. Championship points will be determined from times, and awarded to the 6 fastest swimmers in each event.

Ironside Shield (senior swimmers - Grades 5 and 6)

Swimmers for this event have been selected from the 100m freestyle races, which are held before the carnival. Six boys and six girls will race at the senior carnival, to be crowned the Fastest 100m Freestyle Boy and Girl for 2018.

Ironside Gift – Senior Carnival

This is a race between the fastest 50m freestyle girl and boy (any age), determined by times achieved in the 50m freestyle age group races.

Results

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place swimmers in each 50m event during the carnival. Final results for House points and Age Champions will be announced at assembly in Week 10.

Programs and Timelines

Please refer to the programs overleaf, and the APPROXIMATE timeline of events as a guide to when your child/ren will swim.

100m Freestyle Swimmers

The 100m freestyle races for all age groups will take place on Friday, Nove 30th, beginning at 1:15pm. Please make sure your child is aware of this if they have nominated for the 100m.
